Ordinary Time

Most of the church year is organized around the two major festivals that mark sacred time —

Christmas and Easter.

The rest of the year is known as Ordinary Time. This term comes from the word "ordinal," which means "counted time."

Ordinary Time begins in January, breaks for the season of Lent and Easter, and returns after Trinity Sunday, ending with Christ the King Sunday.

Since next Sunday marks the Transfiguration of the Lord; and the first Sunday in Lent is March 10, today is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time until June 23.
