...marks the beginning of Holy Week, which focuses on the final days of Jesus' life, and culminates with Easter Sunday, perhaps the most important holiday in Christianity.

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, on the back of a donkey, as foretold by the prophet Zechariah.

The Bible tells us people cut branches from palm trees, laid them across Jesus' path and waved them in the air, Palm branches symbolized goodness, well-being, and victory. King Solomon had palm branches carved into the walls and doors of the temple. As described in the Book of Revelation, people from every nation raise palm branches to honor Jesus.

Palm branches are an important visual element of today's worship, and you are invited to take one with you as you leave.
