A Voice and A Choice – Working Through Vicarious Trauma

Do you feel weighed down by the injustice and suffering you see in the news? God created us to feel compassion for people in distress. But often that weight immobilizes us, particularly if the people are distant from us and we feel there is nothing we can do to help. Please join CPC justice group Refuge for a talk and discussion on vicarious trauma and how to work through it. CPC's Juanita Ryan will lead us. Juanita has been a therapist in private practice for over 30 years and is the author of multiple books, bible studies and video series. Her specialties are recovery from trauma and healing from spiritual wounds.
